

Alien Paper Bag Puppet

What you'll need:

- Alien Pattern
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Construction paper or cardstock: Light green, blue and purple
- Pencil
- Black marker
- One paper bag



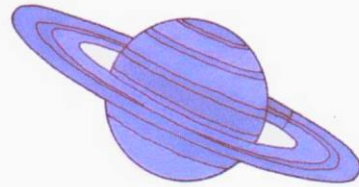
How to make it:

1. Print out the Alien pattern and cut out the pieces from the color construction paper indicated on the pattern.
2. Glue the eye in the center of the head shape. Use a black marker to draw in a mouth and also to draw in two lines for the inside of the ears. Glue the antenna to the back of the head. Paste the head to the bottom flap of the bag.
3. Glue the hands to the end of each of the arm pieces and then attach the arms to the bag with tape in the crease of the bag – one on each side of the bag.
4. Lift the flap of the bag and attach the chest to the bag with glue stick, placing one straight edge at the crease of the bag underneath the head.
5. Glue the feet to each end of the pants and then attach the pants below the chest with glue stick.
6. Last attach the belt along the seam where the chest and pants meet. Glue the buckle to the center of the belt and glue the planet to the front of the chest.





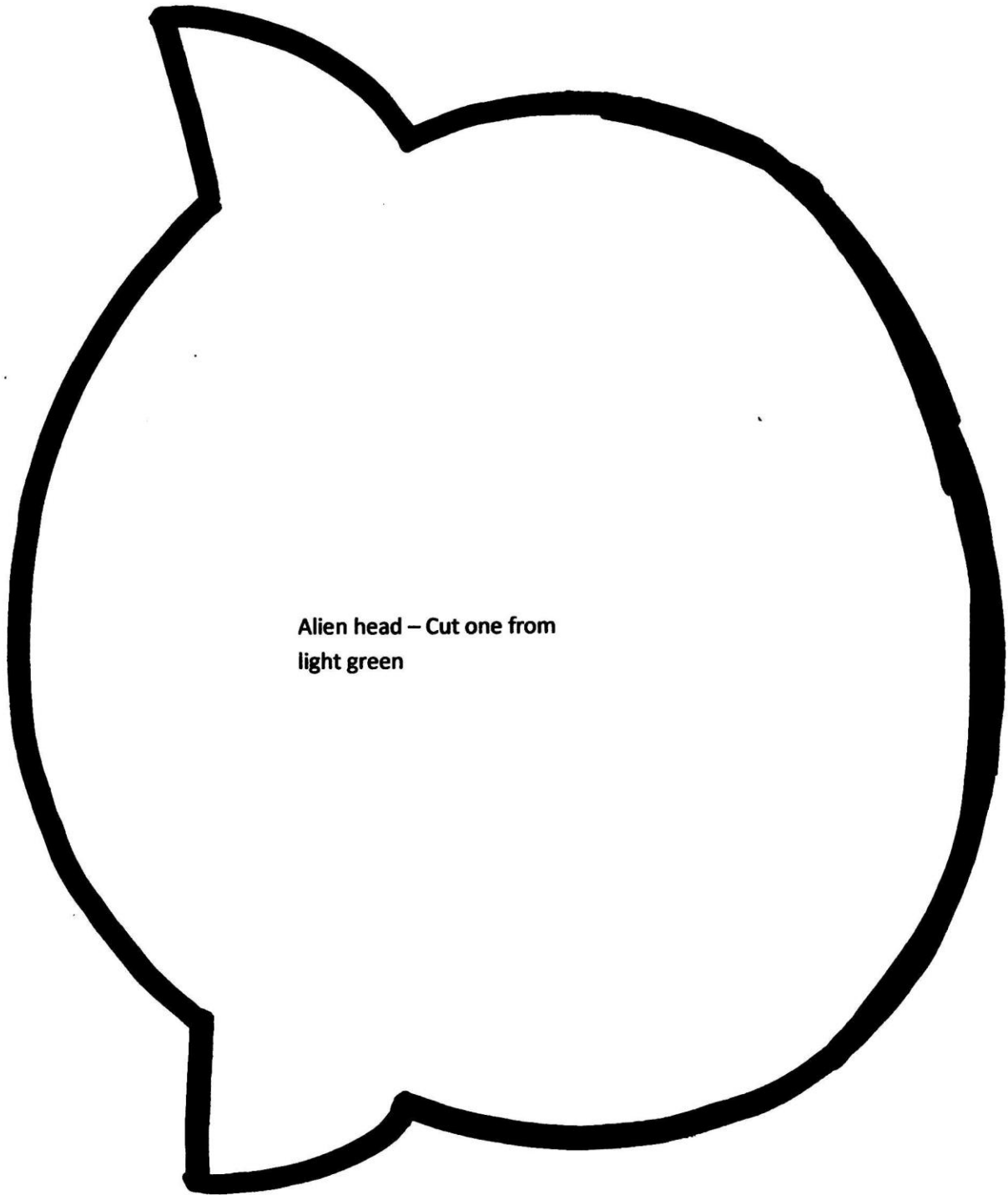
Alien Hand – cut

green



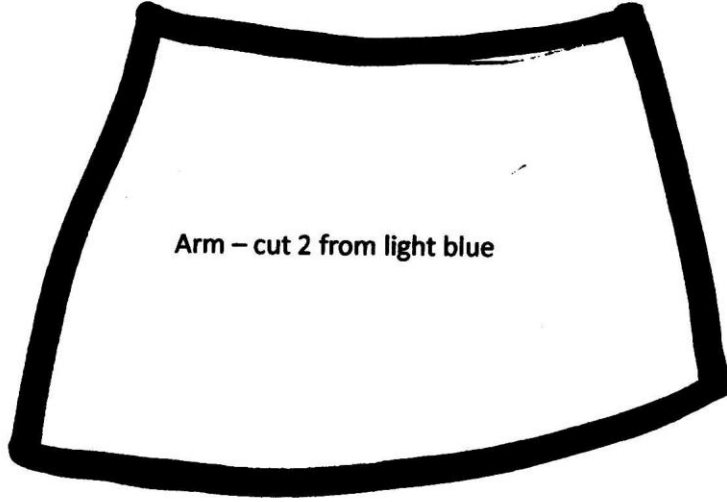
Alien foot – cut 2
from light green



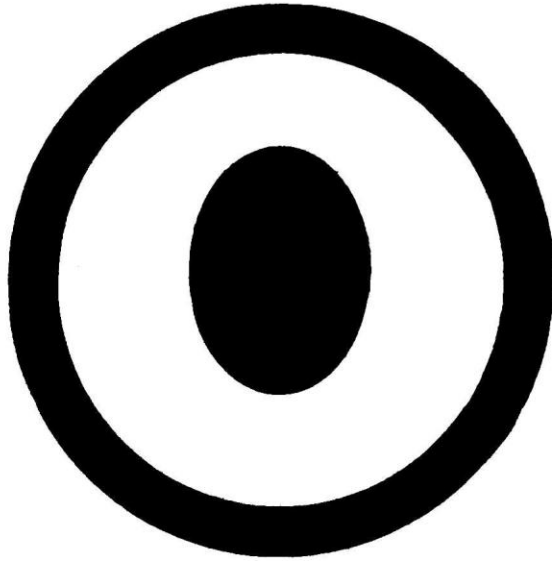
Antenna – cut

green



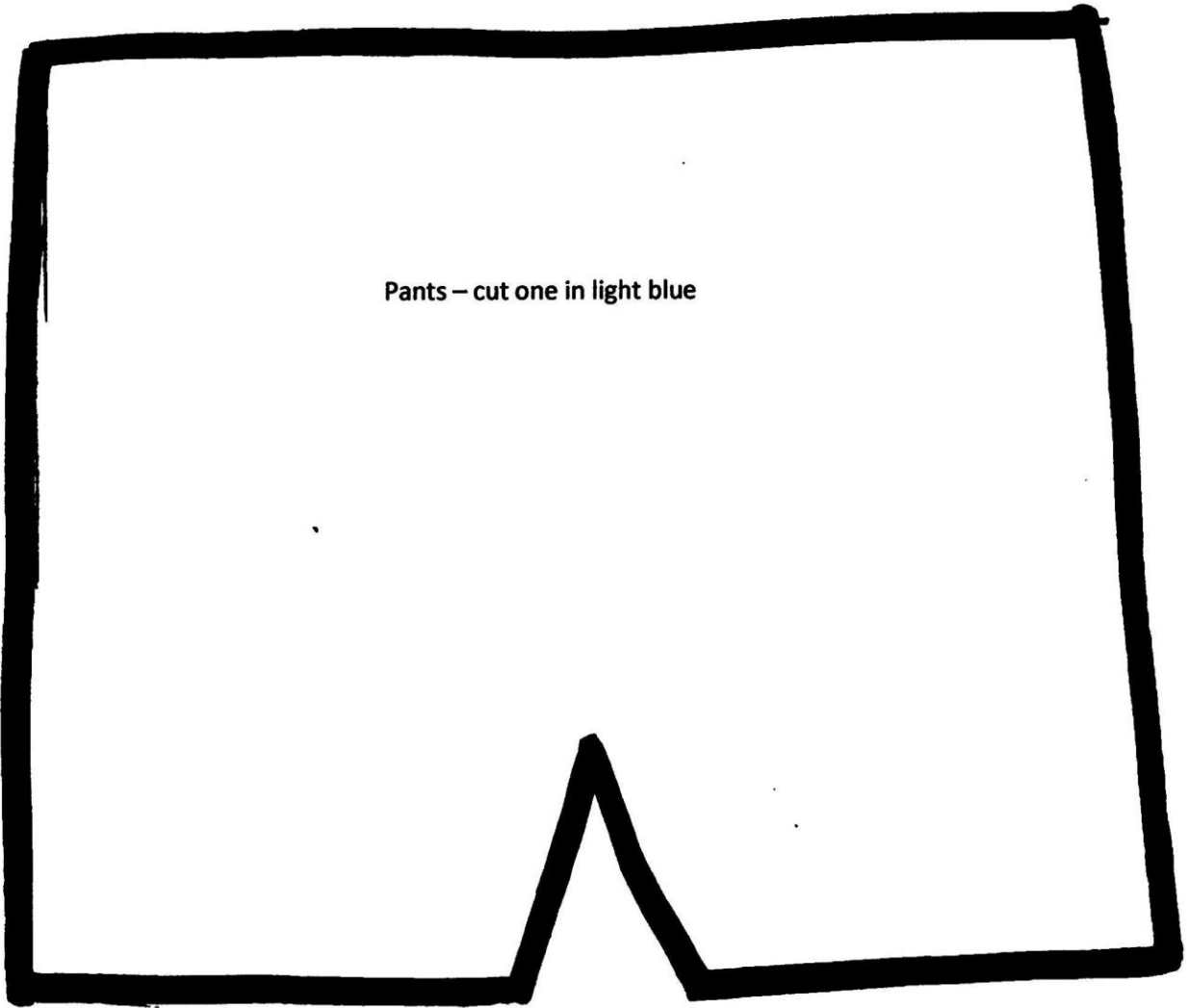
**Alien head – Cut one from
light green**



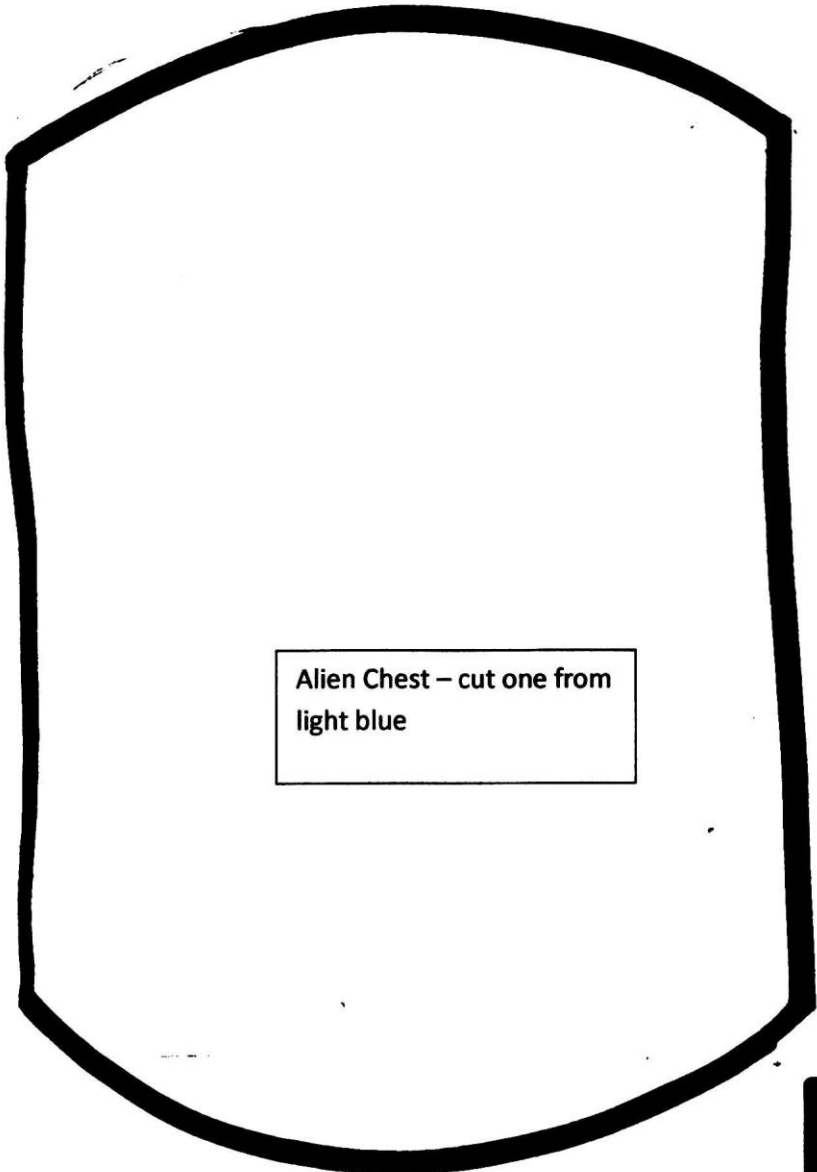
Arm - cut 2 from light blue



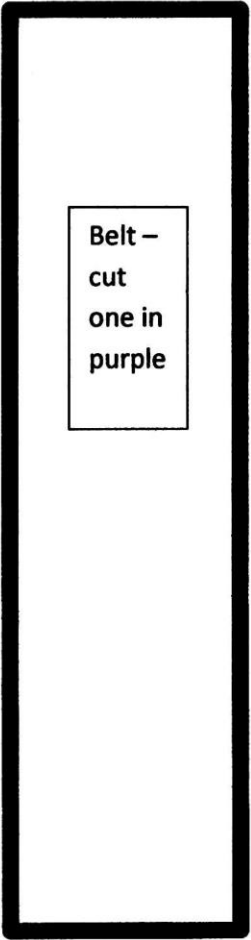
Alien eye - cut out and paste
to front of Alien head



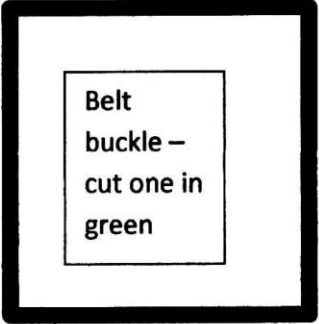
Pants – cut one in light blue
